1.0 Purpose

This Privacy Policy describes our policies and procedures regarding the collection, use, and disclosure of your information when you use our Service. It also outlines your privacy rights and how the law protects you.

Interpretation

Definitions

Account means a unique account created for you to access our Service or parts of our Service.

Affiliate means any entity that controls, is controlled by, or is under common control with a party.

Cookies are small files placed on your device by a website, often used to track browsing activity.

Country refers to North Carolina, United States.

- b) Browser type and version
- c) Pages visited and time spent
- d) Device identifiers
- e) Mobile device information (if applicable)

3.1.3 Tracking Technologies and Cookies

3.1.3.1 We use cookies and similar tracking technologies (e.g., beacons, tags, scripts) to analyze activity and improve the Service.

Cookie Type	Purpose
Essential (Session)	Necessary for Service functionality and security.
Acceptance (Persistent)	Tracks cookie consent.
Functionality (Persistent)	Remembers preferences (e.g., language, login details).

3.1.3.2 You can manage or disable cookies in your browser settings, though some features of the Service may be affected.

3.2 Use of Your Personal Data

3.2.1 We may use your data to:
